#### **Test Week Guidelines**

- 9-12 Students
  - o Must attend 1 of the required semester test blocks
    - Testing blocks are scheduled based on which section that you attend
      - Example:
        - o 1st period government students will attend semester test block 1
        - o 6<sup>th</sup> period government students will attend semester test block 2
  - Students do not need to be in attendance for any other time unless they have missing/late/incomplete work or for test retakes.
  - Any students in the building, but not testing must report to the study hall
- Junior High Students
  - 7-8 student will be in attendance for all of Thursday.
    - Testing blocks are scheduled based on which section you attend
      - Example:
        - 7<sup>th</sup> period 8<sup>th</sup> Grade English will attend semester test block 1
          - All other 8<sup>th</sup> graders will attend study hall
        - 8th period 8th Grade English will attend semester test block 2
          - All other 8th graders will attend study hall
  - Any students in the building, but not testing must report to the study hall
- Grades 7-12
  - Students with any missing/late/incomplete work or with test retakes are required to attend Thursday and Friday until work is completed to a satisfactory level as determined by the teacher
    - Students should work with individual teachers to develop a plan/schedule for completing work
  - Students are required to turn their devices into their testing teacher at the completion of their required testing period
    - If students need their device to complete any missing/late work, they will work with their testing teacher or Mr. Jahner to schedule a time to turn device in
